The "Spaatz" in Wasserbillig, at 130 m above sea level, is the lowest point in the Grand Duchy. The passenger vessel "MuselSchëff" embarks on guided tours at the confluence of the Sauer and Moselle. Travelling up the Moselle, discover the beautiful electric powered "Sankta Maria" in the wine-growing communities of Oberbillig (Germany) and Luxemburg's only inland port in Mertert. The port handles 1.5 million tons each year with many specialties and goods being made by ship. The wine-growing area in the port is where the Sankta Maria wine is produced on the Moselle. The wine is famous for its quality and one of the best in the world. The wine is produced in a cellar of approx. 90 million litres. When at our wine cellar, we find our wine. Besides the wine-producing town of Mertert, the "patron" is the Moselle. The modern bridge in Luxemburg's wine region is the "Sankta Maria" bridge. The Moselle is a beautiful river but there are many successful wine cellars.
